Event Plan

Foothills Event Management, LLC is committed to running a successful **Mustaches & Mullets 7 Charity Adult Hockey Tournament August 14-16, 2020** that focuses on supporting Disabled Athletes & their Families, while also protecting the safety and wellness of our Beneficiaries, Sponsors, Partners, Contributors, Vendors, Participants, Referees, Scorekeepers, Volunteers, Event Staff, Facility Staff and Spectators.

After meeting with the **Foothills Park & Recreation District - Edge Ice Arena Management** and reviewing the latest guidelines from the **Colorado Department of Health and Environment (CDPHE)**, we are putting several procedures in place that will require our mutual teamwork to help create a successful and safe event. The Edge Ice Arena has had a successful return to the rink, including Adult Hockey and is operating under the guidelines from CDPHE which can be found here:

COVID-19 Procedures

- **Participants** will follow **Signage** for **designated Entry** through **Edge Ice Arena Main Upper Doors** and **Exit** through **Facility Lower Rear Doors** near **Zamboni Room**.

This will help minimize social interaction through **One-Way Traffic Flow**.

Games are staggered to allow for only two Teams at-a-time to enter the Facility approximately 15 minutes before the designated Game Time and will be allowed 10 minutes in the Locker Room. Players will be encouraged to pre-dress as much as possible before entering the Facility to minimize Locker Room time.



- **Masks** will be required in the building while off-the-ice when Participants aren't actively eating or drinking. Additional Masks will be available at Registration.
- **Contactless Temperatures** will be taken from every Participant by either FEM Event Staff or Volunteers upon Entry.
- **Questions** will be asked of every Participant upon Entry into the Facility.
 - ❖ *Are you currently sick?*
 - ❖ *Do you have any of the following?*
 - *Fever 100.4°F or above*
 - *Cough*
 - *Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing*
 - *Chills*
 - *Muscle aches*
 - *Sore throat*
 - *New loss of taste or smell*
 - ❖ *Have you been exposed to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days?*

- **Signage** with the following Information will be posted at the dedicated Entry:

WELCOME TO MUSTACHES & MULLET 7

If you are feeling ill, symptomatic (see below), or believe you have been in contact with anyone who may have COVID-19, please excuse yourself from the Event.

- Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- **Hand Sanitizer** will be fully stocked and readily available at Registration.
 - **Social Distancing** is the responsibility of every Participant in any Common Areas or designated Waiting Areas.
 - **Number of Teams** has been reduced from 32 to 26.
 - **Event Schedule** is impacted overall due to an increase in **Time between Games** from a typical 15 minutes to a mandatory 30 minutes.
 - **Rosters** created through **TeamSnap Registration** will be enforced via **ID Checks by FEM Event Staff** for Contact Tracing purposes. Captains will verify with Scorekeepers before every Game.
 - **On-Ice Participants** will be limited to 26 Skaters not including the Goalies, Referees, Scorekeepers or any Coaches.
 - **Locker Rooms** will be set up with visual 6' social distancing. Locker Rooms time will be limited to ten minutes, so Locker Rooms can be properly cleaned and sanitized between Games. **SHOWERS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE TO PLAYERS.** **If they are used your Team will forfeit Locker Room privileges for the remainder of the Event.**
 - **Individual Water Bottles must be used by any Participants.** Water Fountains in the Facility will be inaccessible.
 - **Cleaning & Sanitizing**
 - Edge Ice Arena Employees will monitor, clean and sanitize the high-traffic areas including Restrooms, Locker Rooms, Referee Rooms and Dasher Boards in-between Games or at least hourly.
 - Edge Ice Arena Employees will clean and sanitize the Bench, Penalty Boxes, and Scorekeeper Box in-between Games.

- **Limited Players/Spectators** will be allowed back into the Bleacher Area through the Facility Entry for a 1-Hour Period following their Game after leaving through designated Exit and taking their Gear to their Cars.
No Player Bags allowed Inside Facility except while Playing.
- **Limited Vendors** will be allowed to sell Merchandise and both Vendor and Patron will be responsible for maintaining social distance requirements around their Table.
